

This is the final report of the year, marking the close of both the calendar year and our school year. In the past months, our students have been preparing for their final assessments, focusing on revision and strengthening their understanding. Yet, alongside this academic effort, school life remained vibrant and lively. The children took part in various activities and celebrated special days, filling the campus with joy, colour, and a strong sense of community.



### **1. Major Events & Celebrations**

#### **a. Music/Dance and Art days**

In December, we organized two creative events at the school – a dance and music program, and an art day, which also included children from nearby villages. Both events were designed primarily as opportunities for collaboration and shared creativity, since children in the villages do not often have access to such activities. These events allowed them to showcase their talents, connect with peers, and experience something new. All participants received certificates, and a few were awarded trophies as additional encouragement to continue developing their creativity.



## b. Children's Day Celebration

The Children's Day celebration was a joyful and meaningful occasion. Teachers from both the primary and secondary sections prepared a wonderful program that included dramas, skits, dances, recitations, and songs — a true showcase of their creativity and talent. Students enjoyed the lively performances and took part in fun games and activities throughout the day. As a gesture of love and encouragement, teachers gifted each junior student a pencil-case with stationery and snacks, while senior students received a small living plant to nurture and care for. The celebration ended with a hearty lunch shared together, creating a warm sense of community and togetherness.



## c. Annual Village Fair

Students presented a rich variety of music, dance, drama, and cultural performances before a large community audience. The event began with a musical performance featuring students playing instruments, followed by a skit highlighting the dangers of social media — a powerful message for both children and adults.

There were several energetic dance performances, showcasing different styles and age groups. The peak of the event was a dramatic dance performance, which captivated the audience with its creativity and emotional impact. We are proud to share that this performance won First Prize, bringing great joy and motivation to our students and teachers.

The fair not only strengthened community ties but also gave students meaningful public exposure, confidence, and a sense of achievement.



#### d. Christmas Celebrations

December brought great festive joy to the school. Students performed Christmas songs, carols, and dance numbers, while food stalls offered homemade snacks and festive treats. The entire campus was decorated with stars, lights, handmade ornaments, and a nativity scene, creating a warm atmosphere of sharing and togetherness. Many visitors joined us for the celebration — parents, benefactors, friends, and well-wishers — filling the school with warmth and laughter. It was a wonderful time of being together, sharing food, exchanging stories, and celebrating the joy of the season as one school community.



## **2. Craft Activities**



Throughout the year, students created useful and beautifully crafted items, gradually developing their manual skills, precision, and sense of design. They made wall organizers with pockets, jute bags, decorative and functional objects, as well as small ornaments that decorated classrooms and school corridors. During the process, they learned a variety of techniques — from cutting,

gluing, and stitching to painting and planning shapes — while strengthening their perseverance and ability to create independently. The youngest students proudly made their very first craft items. Each piece was an achievement for them, as they practiced imagination, patience, concentration, and fine motor skills. These creative sessions brought the children great joy, while also helping them build confidence and a sense of accomplishment, knowing that they can create something both beautiful and useful with their own hands.



## **3. Parents' Meetings**



Throughout the school year, we held several meetings with parents, aimed at providing support and guidance to families. The discussions focused on the importance of an active and encouraging parental role in a child's education, on motivating children, and on establishing a varied yet stable daily routine at home. We also shared simple and practical ways in which parents can support their children's learning every day. We explored several important parenting topics — how to build positive and respectful communication with children, how to avoid physical punishment, and how to handle challenging situations calmly and constructively. A special part of the meetings was dedicated to girls entering adolescence: we helped parents understand their needs, changes, and emotional challenges during this sensitive stage of growth. These meetings greatly strengthened collaboration, trust, and partnership between the school and families, and enhanced the shared sense of responsibility for the well-being and development of the children.



#### 4. Fusion Exhibition – where subjects meet



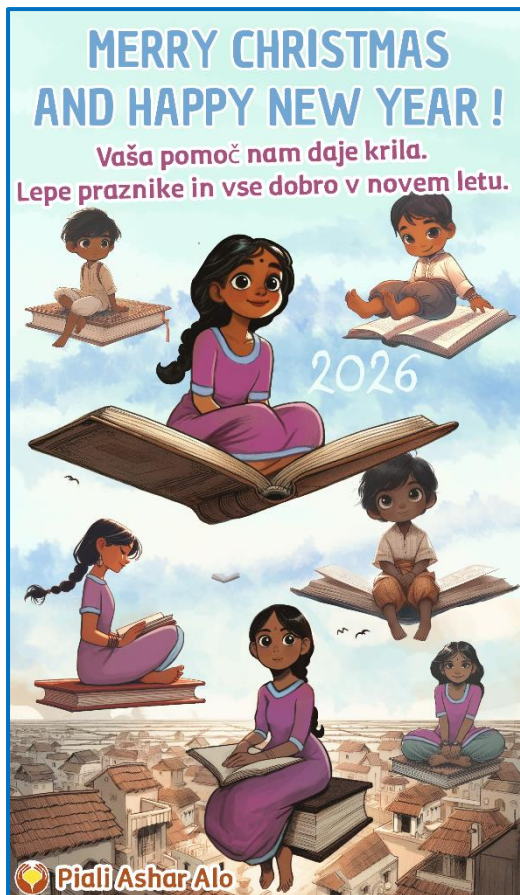
